- All sales are final, and there are no exchanges on items. The auction committee has carefully written the item descriptions, including all understood restrictions. In the event of any discrepancy, the restrictions printed directly on a gift certificate will govern the item.
- Auction items must be used within their specified time limits.
- Donations to the Angel Fund will be used solely for the purpose of Financial Assistance for current and incoming students enrolled at Bishop Stang through a need-based process. Gifts to the Angel Fund are fully deductible as allowed by law, since donors receive no direct benefit for their gift.
- Following IRS regulations, we inform you that the charitable deduction for a purchased item is limited to the excess value of the gift over the value of the goods or services provided.
- Items can be bid upon and purchased by online bidders who have registered for the event through our OneCause/BidPal event website.
