Computer Device Requirements

Mastering technology is an essential skill for preparing young men and women for success in college and the workforce. At Bishop Stang, we ensure that our graduates acquire skills by integrating technology standards across the curriculum. We will also continue with our current **1:1 “Bring Your Own Device” (BYOD)** technology policy ***which requires all students to bring their own laptop computer to school each day.***

The **BYOD** program will build upon the following goals:

- Enhancement of 21st century skills - digital literacy, organization, communication and collaboration;
- Continued access to the Internet via the school’s wireless network for research purposes;
- Enhanced access to curriculum resources;
- Access to cloud storage, email, calendar and communication systems.

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Minimum Specifications

1. **Wireless connectivity:** Devices must have a wireless connection to school WiFi.
2. **Battery Life:** Devices must last at least 5 hours without charge so they will last the whole day. Purchasing a backup charger to leave in your locker is recommended.
3. **Hardware features:** Students should have a wireless mouse available if needed.
4. **Minimum Hardware Requirements:**
Due to compatibility issues with MacBooks, it is suggested that students have a Windows 11 device. Devices should have an Intel Core i5/i7 (10th Gen+) or AMD Ryzen 5/7 (4000 series+) or higher CPU, minimum of 16GB RAM, and a minimum 256GB SSD.
5. **Software:** Students must have Google Chrome installed on their device. This will be the browser used at school.
6. **Important Notice:** ***Due to lack of compatibility, Chromebooks, iPads and other tablets are not acceptable devices.***
