Dear Bishop Stang Families:

The Re-Enrollment process at Bishop Stang High School for the 2026-2027 academic school year is designed to allow each student to participate in the course selection process. Students are strongly encouraged to discuss their courses with their parents/guardians, school counselors, teachers, and department chairpersons with the goal of designing a challenging and personalized college-preparatory program of study that meets graduation requirements, college entrance requirements, and career preparation. We ask that students, parents, and families please review the academic and graduation requirements for Bishop Stang in the 2026-27 Program of Studies.

Bishop Stang's philosophy is to place all students at the highest level at which they will be sufficiently challenged and can also achieve academic success. We offer a wide variety of courses at multiple levels and strongly encourage parents to discuss course selection questions with their student's school counselor. If students request a level change, they must meet all requirements for level advancement in the Program of Studies.

It is very important that you conduct the registration process carefully and consider it a contractual agreement between you and the school. This process determines staffing, course offerings, and availability of classes. Bishop Stang reserves the right to eliminate any course offered due to insufficient enrollment.

Process Course Selection:

1. After reading this overview, students and parents should discuss potential course options/plans at home and use the course selection worksheets to guide your discussion.
2. Counselors will meet with students individually during the month of February/March to select courses based on teacher recommendations, graduation requirements, future career interests, etc.
3. Once your son/daughter's schedule is finalized, a copy will be e-mailed to you to approve the selected courses and/or request any reviews or changes.
