Technology Requirements 1:1 Bring Your Own Device Program

Mastering technology is an essential skill for preparing young men and women for success in college and the workforce. At Bishop Stang, we aim to ensure that our graduates acquire skills by integrating technology standards across the curriculum. **Our 1:1 Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Technology Policy requires all students to bring their own laptop computer to school each day.**

The BYOD Program builds upon the following program goals:

- **Digital readiness:** Strengthen digital literacy, organization, communication, and collaboration.
- **Research access:** Provide continued Internet access through the school's wireless network.
- **Curriculum access:** Expand access to course materials and digital learning resources.
- **School systems:** Support cloud storage, email, calendars, and communication platforms.

Minimum Device Specifications	
Requirement	Minimum standard
Wireless connectivity	Devices must connect to the school's Wi-Fi network
Battery life	At least 5 hours of use on a full charge. A backup charger, kept in the student's locker, is recommended.
Accessory	Wireless mouse should be available if needed.
Recommended platform	Windows 11 is recommended because MacBooks may not be compatible with all online testing platforms
Processor	Intel Core i5/i7 (10th Generation or newer) or AMD Ryzen 5/7 (4000 series or newer), or higher performance processor.
Memory and storage	Minimum 16 GB RAM and 256 GB solid-state drive (SSD)
Required software	Google Chrome must be installed. This is the browser used at school.
Important Notice: Chromebooks, iPads and other tablets are not permitted as BYOD devices.	

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
