- **Continuum of Support for Students without Diagnosis, IEP, or documented learning difference:** We take great pride in working with all of our students to help them reach their full potential and succeed academically. All students are assigned a school counselor, who will serve as the starting point for all supports at Bishop Stang High School. If a student has an accommodation plan that does not require specialized services, those students will be monitored by their counselor.
